First Lady Designates Nine New Preserve America Stewards

WASHINGTON, D.C. – First Lady of the United States Michelle Obama has signed designation letters for nine new Preserve America Stewards, bringing the total nationwide to 30.

"Preserve America Stewards are volunteer programs that have accomplished successful efforts in preserving the nation's historic places," said Wayne Donaldson, chairman of the federal Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). "Historic preservation has always relied upon motivated, active volunteers who understand that it is an individual as well as community responsibility to make certain that significant historic places remain to enrich and enlighten present and future generations."
